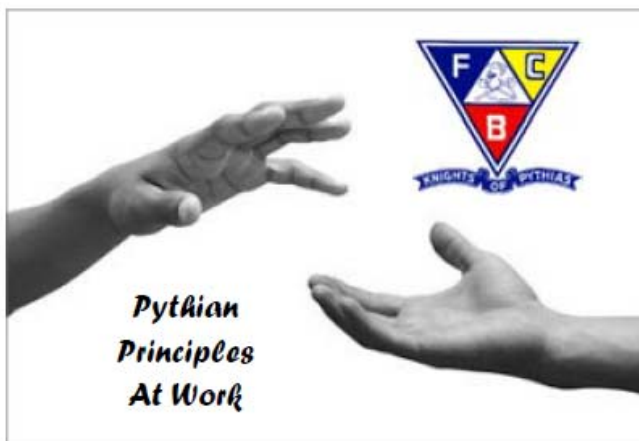
OWATONNA LODGE #62 (Cleveland, Ohio) PRESENTS SPECIAL STARS Bowling Award Medals
