In Memoriam – Sir Hayden Woolum, KGS, PSR March 4, 1927 – May 11, 2017



The Supreme Ruler of the Universe has called Sir Hayden Woolum, Past Grand Chancellor and Knight of the Golden Spur, to take his place in peace eternal. Sir Hayden became a Pythian in Lafayette Lodge No. 37 on December 7, 1968. He later advance through the officer line to become a Past Chancellor of the Lodge and served the Grand Lodge of Ohio

as its Grand Chancellor in 1990-91. He continued to faithfully participate in the activities of the Grand Lodge and served as the Master at Arms for many, many Founder's Day Classes until his health would no longer permit him to travel. He was a Past Supreme Representative and had also served the Grand Lodge as a Grand Trustee. He was also a proud member of the Dramatic Order of Knights of Khorassan. He was known for his sense of humor and pranks at Grand Lodge functions and loved to have fun with his Pythian Brothers and Sisters. He will be sorely missed & fondly remembered!

Pythian Historical Marker Dedication - April 21, 2017



The Union Township Hall has stood for more than 100 years at 100 E. McKinley St. in South Lebanon, Ohio. It has served many purposes for the South Lebanon community and for many years prior to World War II, was the Castle Hall for Miami Valley Lodge No. 703 (chartered in 1897 and closed in 1936). The Warren County Historical Society and Lebanon Citizens National Bank sponsored placement of an Ohio Historical Marker at the

Hall and the Knights of Pythias is recognized on the marker. A dedication ceremony was held on April 21, 2017, during which the Grand Chancellor and Grand Secretary of Ohio were privileged to address an audience of local attendees and a number of visiting Pythians. Many thanks to the primary organizer of this effort, Ms. Maryan Harrison, who went out of her way to include our Order in this historical event! IMPORTANT RULING BY THE SUPREME TRIBUNAL — We previously published a decision by the Grand Tribunal of Ohio that convicted felons were ineligible for membership in our Order. Upon appeal and review, the Supreme Tribunal has overturned this decision. The Supreme Tribunal has ruled that conviction of a felony does not automatically make someone ineligible for membership. It is ultimately the responsibility of each subordinate Lodge and its investigating committee to determine if a candidate is of good moral character and worthy of membership. So it is up to the Lodge's investigating committee to be diligent in performing their duties and inquiring into the moral character of each petitioner, reporting back to the Lodge, and the members giving careful consideration to the committee's report and advice prior to balloting upon a petitioner. This is an AWESOME responsibility and should be taken very seriously! Guard well the portals of our Castle Halls! Don't take a petitioner's investigation lightly! Food for thought: If you would not be comfortable with a petitioner being in your home with your family, then why would you let him in your Lodge?


